- Page Charges have been received within six months of invoice sent by the publisher.
- The university/institution of the authors has a current subscription to the IJEE and it is in good standing in regard to payments.
- The paper will remain on open access as long as the first and second criteria are fulfilled.

Also, the publisher provides a prompt payment discount of 15% for all authors who make payments within 90 days of date of invoice.

I wish to thank all the authors for their valued contributions and I hope the readers find the papers included in this issue to be interesting and useful.
